Collection of your Personal Information

Use of your Personal Information

Homescoutmedia Pty Ltd collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

The company may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from us and our affiliates. The company may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Homescoutmedia Pty Ltd does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

The company may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is transferred to the third party. Use of Cookies

The Homescoutmedia Pty Ltd website may use “cookies” to help you personalise your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalise the company pages, or register with the company site or services, a cookie helps the company to recall your specific information on subsequent visits.
